SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR DONATIONS TO REBUILD CLASSROOMS DESTROYD IN FIRE INCIDENT

J.G. Van der Wath Secondary School in Okahandja aims to impart quality education to learners enrolled to our school. They are coming from orphanages or poor families and it is therefore imperative that whilst they are in their formative school years, we equip them for tertiary education as well as the working world, especially those that might not be able to secure funding to further their studies. Our learner enrolment this year stands at just over 690.

The school has over the years also achieved measurable success in honing its learners' education and extra-curricular capabilities. Despite limited resources and School Development Fund, our learners are performing exceptionally well in external national examinations (both grade 10 and grade 12) and extra-curricular activities.

Fire Incident

The early evening of June 7, 2019 will be immortalized in the history books of our school, as the day that none of us ever thought could happened. A day that changed not only the outlook and set pace with which classes were run, but the landscape of 5 decently stocked and maintained classrooms due to a fire outbreak. Of these 5 classrooms and storerooms, two were destroyed beyond salvaging and three further down suffered amongst others, mainly smoke and water damage, all thanks to the brave rescue efforts of the local fire brigade and community members.

Although the need is greater, so far, the Ministry of Education, as contingency plan was only able to replace 90 school desks and chairs which were used to set up temporary classrooms. It is for this reasons that the school has embark-upon a fundraising campaign to renovate and replaced/acquire some of the needed teaching resources lost in the fire.

We are busy working on stringent plans to make sure such incidents do not repeat, and/or that the damages wouldn't be these extreme. We will also appreciate it if your company/office could come on board and assist us herewith
